#### **Dress Code for Summer Band**

Students must wear tennis shoes (preferably cross-trainers as running shoes do not provide enough lateral support). No other shoe is acceptable for marching band. Any other shoe (basketball shoes, sandals, flip-flops, boots, high-heels, Crocs – even in sport mode) constitutes a health hazard. CLICK HERE for the latest DCI Recommended Shoe List for Marching Musicians. Hats must be worn as well. In band, you need to be able to see, and the brim of a hat can shield your eyes from the glare of the sun, plus it keeps the harmful UV Rays off of your head! Sunglasses are a necessity when outside but are to be taken off when inside the building. I would encourage you to wear loose-fitting light-colored shirts to summer band due to the heat factor. Shorts are also required; we have had a few boys in the past that thought incorrectly that they could brave the heat in baggy black jeans. All guys must wear a shirt and no one may wear any article that is in violation of the school dress code. Students should bring water bottles, have them filled before every rehearsal and have applied sunscreen on their own (even if overcast).

# Classes Begin – Wednesday, August 14<sup>TH</sup>

In the fall, band classes will be scheduled as follows: ALL STUDENTS should be DOUBLE-BLOCKED in their band classes. Wind Symphony (Varsity Band) and Battery, Blocks 1/5; Symphonic Band (Sub Non-Varsity Band), Blocks 2/6; Wind Ensemble (Non-Varsity Band) and Front Ensemble, Blocks 3/7 – D Lunch. Colorguard classes should be listed in 4<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Periods. There should be very few conflicts. Please contact Mr. Mullins for more details about what your class schedule should look like. <u>Freshmen</u> should note that band **DOES** count for **PE credit**, and that **SPEECH** and **HEALTH** may not be required and can be taken during your <u>junior year</u> or online (and will not negatively affect your GPA).

### Marching Band Rehearsal Schedule Once Classes Begin

We will use the class periods to concentrate mainly on music rehearsal, so consistent and prompt attendance at our after school rehearsals is crucial to our band's continued success. Outside-of-school practices will be dedicated to learning and cleaning the visual aspects of the show in full band rehearsals and are 100% dependent on 100% of the band being present to accomplish our daily goals.

Students with jobs will need to plan their work schedule so that it will not conflict with these band rehearsals, as attendance is a requirement of enrollment in the class and will affect their grade. Sorry, no student will be excused due to work conflicts. Students will have at least three hours a week for tutorials in other classes. Since our schedule offers so many opportunities for tutorial help, any tutorials during a scheduled rehearsal day are only excused at the discretion of the directors, with written notice from the teacher at least ONE DAY PRIOR TO THE REHEARSAL MISSED. With our weekly schedule, we ask that you do not schedule medical/dental appointments during an after-school band rehearsal or sectional. The optimum times to schedule appointments are the mornings or after school before rehearsal. Unexcused absences will affect grading since participation is a major portion of the marching band curriculum. Though excused absences will not affect grading, anyone who misses rehearsals may be placed as an alternate for the betterment of the band.
